YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT A GENERAL ELECTION, A DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY AND A REPUBLICAN PRIMARY WILL BE HELD IN ALL VOTING PRECINCTS IN WASHINGTON COUNTY, TENNESSEE ON **Thursday, August 7, 2008**. IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATUTES OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE FOR THE FOLLOWING OFFICES AND ANY OTHER OFFICES AS REQUIRED BY STATUE:

1. Independent candidates for Washington County Commission, 1st Commission District (unexpired term) to be filled in the August General Election as follows:

QUALIFYING DEADLINE: Thursday, April 3, 2008, 12:00 NOON

1st Commission District – Towne Acres North, Boones Creek Middle School, Boones Creek Christian Church-Inside the City, Boones Creek Christian Church–West–Outside the City, Lake Ridge.

WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE: Thursday, April 10, 2008, 12:00 NOON

A candidate previously filing a nominating petition may withdraw as such candidate by filing a request in writing. Such request to be filed with each office in which the nominating petition was filed on or before **12:00 NOON – Thursday, April 10, 2008**.

2. Independent candidates for Washington County School Board to be filled in the August General Election as follows:

QUALIFYING DEADLINE: Thursday, April 3, 2008, 12:00 NOON

2nd School Board District (Elect 3) – Keystone, North Side, Asbury, Woodland, Henry Johnson, Fairmont, Indian Trail, Towne Acres-South, Towne Acres-North, Marvin’s Chapel, Jonesborough Town Hall, Jonesborough Courthouse

3rd School Board District (1 unexpired term) – Fall Branch, Stratton, Princeton, Boones Creek Middle School, Boones Creek Christian Church-Inside, Boones Creek Christian Church-Outside, Lake Ridge, Gray-City, Gray-East, Gray-West, Harmony, Sulphur Springs, Bowmantown

WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE: Thursday, April 10, 2008, 12:00 NOON

A candidate previously filing a nominating petition may withdraw as such candidate by filing a request in writing. Such request to be filed with each office in which the nominating petition was filed on or before **12:00 NOON – Thursday, April 10, 2008**.

3. Democratic, Republican Primary candidates and Independent candidates for the following offices:

Tennessee House of Representatives–6th and 7th House Districts

QUALIFYING DEADLINE: Thursday, April 3, 2008, 12:00 NOON

As provided by TCA 2-5-104(a), each **INDEPENDENT** candidate or **PRIMARY** candidate for an office other than those filing under TCA 2-5-103, Local or District offices shall file the original nominating petition with the Chair or Administrator of Elections of the county election commission in the county in which the candidate is a resident and shall file **certified duplicates** of the nominating petition with the Chairs or Administrators of the county election commissions in all counties wholly or partially within the area served by the office which the candidate seeks on or before **THURSDAY, April 3, 2008 at 12:00 NOON**. Nominating petitions must be picked up at an Election Commission Office and certified as a petition from the Election Commission and may not be photocopied.

State Representative 6th and 7th Districts

6th Representative District (Washington and Hawkins Counties) – South Central, Conklin, West View, Lamar, Embreeville, Fall Branch, Cherokee-Outside-6th, South Side-6th, Asbury, Woodland-6th, Millennium Center-6th, Henry Johnson-6th, Fairmont-6th, Towne Acres North, Towne Acres South, Indian Trail-6th, Boones Creek Middle School, Boones Creek Christian Church Inside, Boones Creek Christian Church-Outside, Lake Ridge, Marvin’s Chapel-6th, Gray-City, Gray-East, Gray-West, Harmony, Sulphur Springs, Bowmantown, Limestone, **Hawkins County precincts –** Upper Beach, Dykes, and Armory Outside.

7th Representative Districts – Telford, Midway-Outside, Midway-Inside, Cherokee-Outside-7th, Cherokee-Inside, Fire Training Center, South Side-7th, North Side, Keystone, Princeton, Stratton, Woodland-7th, Millennium Center-7th, Henry Johnson-7th, Fairmont-7th, Indian Trail-7th, Jonesborough-Town Hall, Jonesborough-Courthouse, Marvin’s Chapel-7th Dist., Leesburg

An Independent or Primary candidate previously filing a nominating petition may withdraw as such candidate by filing a request in writing. Such request to be filed with each office in which the nominating petition was filed on or before **12:00 NOON – Thursday, April 10, 2008**.

4. Democratic Primary, Republican Primary candidates and Independent candidates for the following offices:

United States Senate and United States House of Representatives

QUALIFYING DEADLINE: Thursday, April 3, 2008 12:00 NOON

As provided by TCA 2-5-103 and TCA 2-5-104 (b) (1) each **INDEPENDENT** Candidate or **PRIMARY** Candidate for an office elected by the voters of the entire State and Candidates for the United States Congress (1st Congressional District) shall file an original nominating petition in the office of the **STATE ELECTION COMMISSION** and a **certified duplicate with the COORDINATOR OF ELECTIONS** and with the **CHAIRPERSON OF THE PARTY’S STATE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE** in case of primary candidates on or before **THURSDAY, April 3, 2008 at 12:00 NOON**.

WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE: THURSDAY, April 10, 2008 – 12:00 NOON

An Independent or Primary candidate previously filing a nominating petition may withdraw as such candidate by filing a request in writing. Such request to be filed with each office in which the nominating petition was filed on or before **12:00 NOON – Thursday, April 10, 2008**.
