To ensure a fair, neutral, and orderly voting environment, all candidates, campaign workers, and voters are reminded that the display or distribution of campaign materials and the solicitation of votes are strictly prohibited within 100 feet of the entrance to any polling place.

This restriction includes, but is not limited to, handing out campaign literature, displaying signs, wearing campaign-related apparel intended to influence voters, or verbally advocating for or against any candidate or measure. The 100-foot boundary is clearly marked at each polling location and must be respected at all times during voting hours.

These guidelines are in place to protect voters' right to cast their ballots free from influence, pressure, or intimidation. Maintaining this campaign-free zone helps preserve the integrity of the election process and ensures that every voter has the opportunity to make their decision in a private and respectful setting.

We appreciate the cooperation of all candidates, campaigners, and voters in adhering to these regulations and helping us uphold a smooth and impartial voting experience for everyone.
